Course Description:

This course focuses on mastery of the PA Academic Standards for Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening with a focus on writing. Students will be exposed to grade level appropriate conventions such as spelling/using frequently used words, capital letters, punctuation, correct grammar and sentence formation. As students progress through this course they will be taught how to develop content appropriate topics. Students will be expected to organize writing in a logical order. While writing, students will use adjectives, nouns and verbs. Through the writing process, students will revise written pieces by adding details for missing information.
