Course Description:

Strings II course focuses on mastery of the PA Academic Standards for the Arts and Humanities and the National Standards for Music Education at the intermediate level. As students progress through this course they will participate in a systematic study of a String Instrument applying tone production, music reading skills, fingerings, articulation, and phrasing to the performance of that instrument at an intermediate level (Grade 2-3 Level Music). At the end of these years of study, the student will participate in a group performance demonstrating the skills learned during the year.
