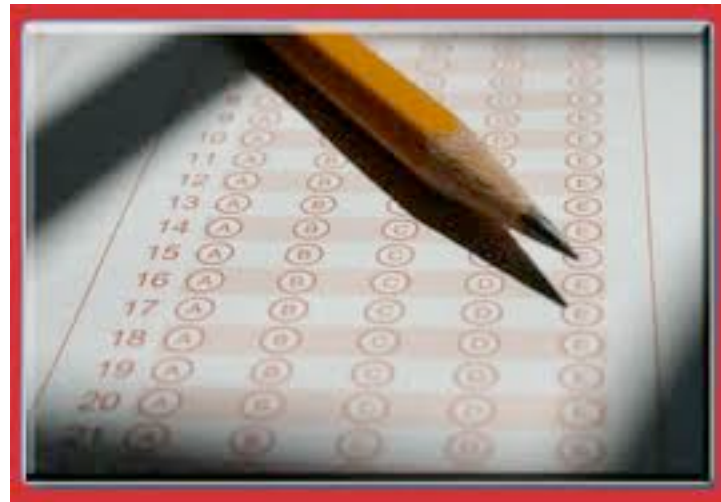

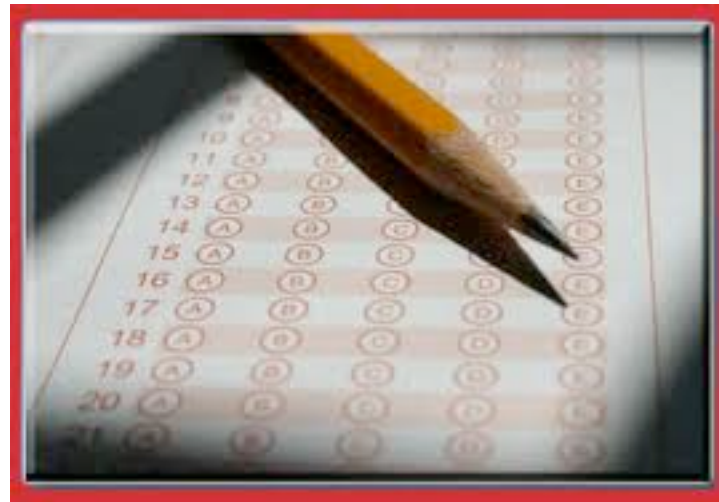

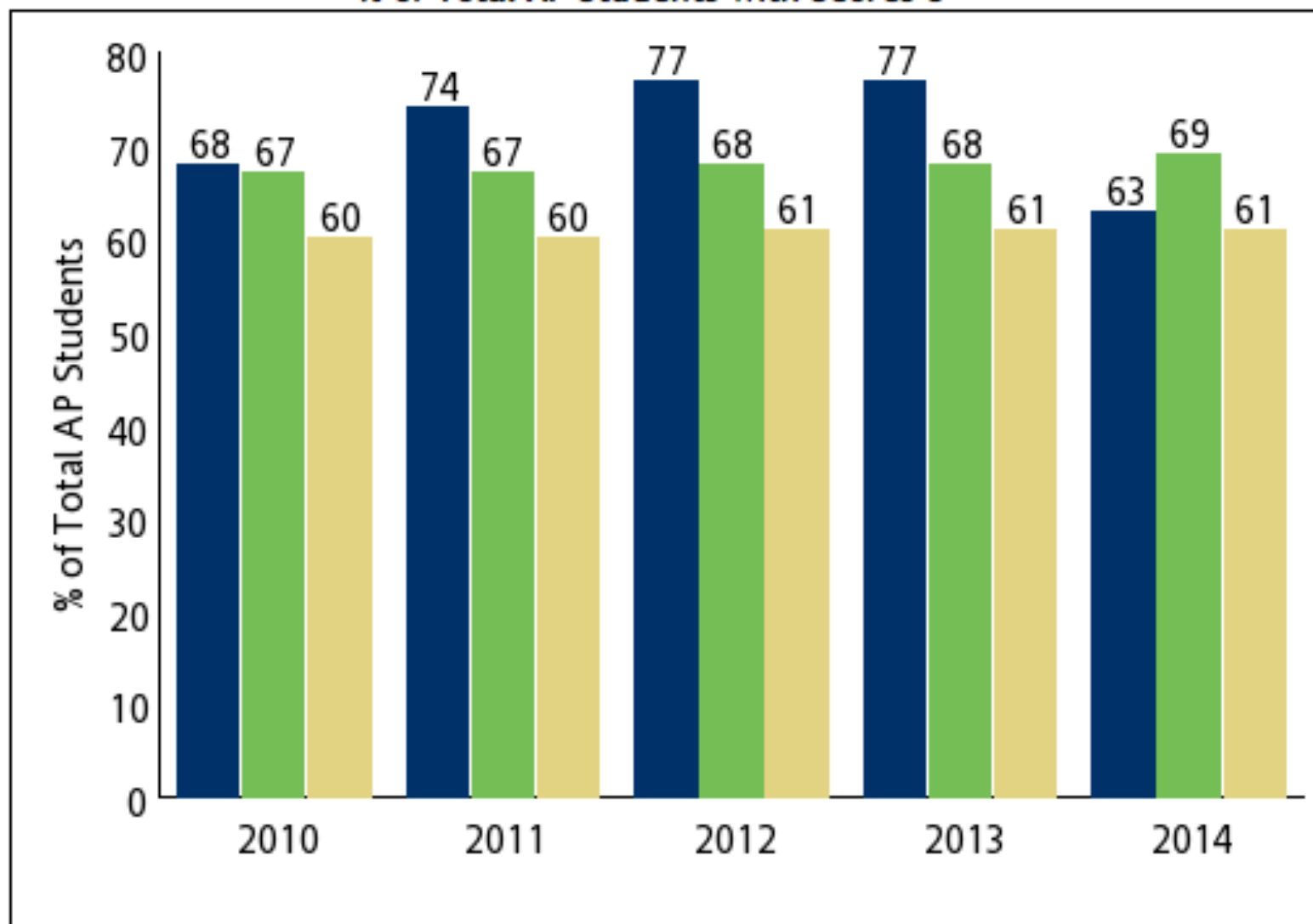

OVERALL CONCLUSIONS

District Strengths

- **Measures of student achievement indicate our early learners in grades K-2 are evidencing solid foundational skills in literacy and mathematics.**
- **PSSA Scores in grades 3-8 reflect strong academic performance across the District, with many grade levels reaching our highest scores of proficiency. There is solid indication of the alignment of assessment, curriculum, instruction, and student learning.**
- **Indicators of preparation for college and career, including SAT, ACT, AP scores reflect strong educational programming and the expertise of the professional staff as well as the support of our families and the Lewisburg community.**

Our Challenges

- **We continue to work towards improved student performance in Keystone end of course assessments as a measure of student achievement and growth as well as meeting graduation requirements in 2017.**
- **We are focusing forward to “new” PSSA tests in spring 2015, configured to PA Core Standards.**
- **We continue to refine our work to meet the challenges of student performance and academic growth for historically underperforming groups of students in our Lewisburg District.**
