# Variables to Consider When Viewing the 2008 Data Results

- The Terra Nova Exams were updated to the Terra Nova 3 version based on 2007 norms and include more rigorous test items correlated to the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) Exam.
- There were several disruptions to the instructional schedule in late January and February due to inclement weather with 5 school closings and 3 delayed openings.
- It was a year of transition at Kelly Elementary School. Eight of the twenty-nine classroom teachers (28%) were new to the school or to their teaching assignment. Also, the building was supervised by four different principals over a six month period.
- Our special education and economically disadvantaged populations increased in comparison to the previous year.

### Terra Nova Achievement Test

Compares our students' performance with a national sample administered to all students in grades K, 1, 2, 9 and 10.


#### **Terminology**

<u>Percentile:</u> Shows how our students scored on the test in comparison to a national sample.


**Example:** A student scoring a 50 did as well or better than 50% of the students in the norm group who took the same test.

**Progress:** Students progressing at the normal rate should score at the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile. Students progressing <u>significantly above</u> average will score at the 75<sup>th</sup> percentile or higher.

## **PSSA**

In 2008 the state required students in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11 to take the PSSA math and reading exams. Grades 5, 8, and 11 were also administered the state writing exam.

The PSSA data is the only information used to assess the Adequate Yearly Progress of our students and evaluate our schools for the No Child Left Behind Law.






## 2008 PSSA Reading Scores - Percentage Advanced & Proficient Lewisburg Scores Compared to State Average



## **Assessment Trends**


This section provides comparisons of how our students have performed at each grade level dating back since 1996 and follows the progress of graduating classes dating back to when they were in fifth grade.

## Reading Performance Level History by Class - Grade 5 to 8 Percent Advanced and Proficient




## Math Performance Level History - Grades 5 to 8 Percent Advanced & Proficient






## Math Performance Level History by Class Grades 8 to 11 Percent Advanced & Proficient






#### **Grade 5 PSSA Scaled Score History - Reading**



#### **Grade 8 Scaled Score History Reading**








#### **Grade 5 PSSA Scaled Score History - Math**



#### **Grade 8 PSSA Scaled Scores History - Math**






#### **Reading Scaled Score History by Class**

## 2008 PSSA Conclusions

#### **Commendations**

- This is the third year in a row that Lewisburg ranks in the top 10% of school districts in the state for overall student performance on the PSSA.
- Overall 85% of Lewisburg students scored at the advanced or proficient performance level in both math and reading.
- The secondary reading and math scores continue to be among the best in the region and some of the highest in the state.

#### **Concerns**

- The disaggregated group scores of IEP Students and Economically Disadvantaged Students continue to be lower than expected and need to improve.
- We need to improve the performance level scores at some elementary grade levels.

# Overall Conclusions

#### **District Strengths**

- High national achievement test scores at the secondary level.
- Excellent PSSA math and reading scores at the secondary level and at the fifth grade benchmark year.
- High SAT scores in comparison to state and national average.

#### Areas Needing Improvement for Achievement Growth

- Percentage of students scoring at the advanced and proficient levels must improve for our special education and economically disadvantaged populations.
- We need to refocus our efforts at the elementary level in both reading and math to reverse some of the recent achievement trends in grades K-4.
