ADDENDUM A: BACKGROUND INFORMATION TO INFORM PLAN

Strengths

Our schools exceed performance standards in career measures

All attendance standards met across all buildings

Our schools meet ELA performance targets and growth measures

Our schools meet math performance targets and growth measures

We have a strong aligned curriculum across K-12 in academic content areas.

Challenges

Student subgroups achievement and growth in tested subjects of ELA and math - notably ELL, ED, Special Education students

Supporting students who are struggling to achieve standards as measured in ELA assessments, such as economically disadvantaged students and students with disabilities.

Determining effective ways to work with students' socialemotional well-being, which can preclude effective learning.

Supporting the students who struggle in math with interventions to support learning.

We are challenged to work with our students across all grade levels to promote social-emotional health and self-regulation.

We are challenged to organize programming and interventions to assist students in behaving appropriately in our schools.

We are challenged to examine opportunities that expand beyond our traditional school settings to promote greater community relationships, including opportunities to learn and grow with college and career options.

Strengths

Students are generally engaged in science and perform well in coursework across grade levels.

Teachers are well prepared and deliver hands-on and lab based instruction.
